- Allocation - Frank. Frank was able to regain the .4 we were slated to lose, meaning very little change from this year. Computer Science and Frisbee team coach positions cut, Hebrew has interest but no allocation. Outside Teacher was "very healthy" this year (.7) and we spent a lot. We are funding it at .25 next year, which means it will "just" cover Stephanie Shea-O'Connor and others we often hire from year to year. We are unlikely to get any bounce-back as we did last year because levels are so low, but could recap "a little" should we trade off a veteran teacher for a teacher new to the system. Yes, Dave Soles has been here a while, but no, that's not what we mean when we say "veteran." Motion PASSED unanimously.

This would allow for 12 to still circulate, and 10 to be available for walk-in traffic.
