Motions

Discussions

- Casey spoke about an ongoing problem with a neighborhood man who has insisted on walking his
 German Shepherd on school property off-leash while students were using the field. Because he refused
 to cooperate, police intervention was necessary and he has now been served official No Trespassing
 orders. Should anyone see/encounter him on the fields, don't confront him but contact the main office.
- Dave Soles showed pictures of possible architectural plans made to include roof-top athletic fields that
 we may want in the event of a move to a new building at the Wilson site. Possibilities include one large
 football sized field (allowing for two Frisbee fields) or two smaller fields in different locations. He also
 showed pictures of a high school in New York, now open, with such fields. Eleanor and Casey both agreed
 that it was good to approach this prospect with a positive attitude, and Casey reminded us that in the
 event of a definite decision to move and rebuild, a "Building Level Planning Committee" would be put
 together and the H-B community would have significant input.
